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The Harris County Clerk launches redesigned website

Houston, TX, - The Harris County Clerk's Office launched a redesigned website today, Friday, February 19th. The redesign increases the website's (**www.cclerk.hctx.net**) capacity to accommodate more visitors, as well as increasing its user friendliness.

"Our goal is to continue to work to make visiting the Clerk's website a more pleasing experience for the public", said Kevin Mauzy, Harris County Clerk's Office Chief Deputy, who oversaw the updating of the website. In the last three years, the Clerk's website has averaged approximately a million hits with visitors viewing an average of 18,000,000 pages.

According to Jason Williams, the County Clerk's Director of Information Technology, the redesign is a significant accomplishment. "The new servers, software and overall technological enhancement of the website's infrastructure move it from legacy based technology to industry standard technology. The nuts and bolts are in place to continue to improve it."

In Harris County, the County Clerk's office has three major responsibilities. The Clerk's office maintains records for Commissioners Court, County Probate Courts, and County Civil Courts at Law. The office records real property records including state and federal tax liens; vital statistics records such as marriage licenses; assumed names; and uniform commercial code records.

The County Clerk's office is also responsible for the conduct of county, state and federal elections in the third largest county in the United States. # # #
